

## RUTLAND COUNTY COUNCIL DISTRICT COUNCIL (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE) Multiple Locations Parish of Lyndon CP Order 2024

Rutland County Council District Council ('the Council') has powers under section 16A (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') to make traffic regulation orders affecting the adopted highway within the County of Rutland.

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council now proposes to make an order entitled the Rutland County Council District Council (Temporary Diversion of Vehicular Traffic) Multiple Locations, Parish of Lyndon CP Order 2024 as the Council are satisfied that traffic on the road should be restricted because the Global Birdfair 2024 is proposed to be held on or near the road.

The effect of the order will be that during the dates and times specified below

- All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along the length of road known
  as Church Road from Lyndon village to Lyndon Road.
  The duration of the Closure shall be as follows:12th July 2024 to 14th July 2024
  The closure will be continuously enforced during the period specified.
  Reasonable facilities will be provided to allow access to adjacent premises while the event is in progress.
- All vehicles will be restricted to proceeding at no more than 30mph along the length of road known as Lyndon Road from Manton village to Edith Weston village.
- Two-way traffic signals will be in place to manage traffic entering the Global Birdfair site at Lyndon Top.
- The first bay of taxi rank on Station Road, Oakham will be suspended to allow for a temporary bus stop for the transportation of visitors staying in Oakham to the Bird Fair site.
