	 Local Plan – the planning inspector wanted some further technical work carried out on employment opportunities. It was noted that St Georges Barracks and Woolfox were not included in the current plan however it is known that the current infrastructure around SGB will only support a maximum of 350-500 additional houses in the area. The RCC Local Plan should be finalised in March/April 2026, when further work will be required to comply with the new government legislation around housing. Local Government reorganisation – final options to be debated by RCC on 21st November 2025, with final proposal submitted to the government on 28th November. See RCC's website for more detail. Flooding investigation report and flood risk strategy will be consulted on – Edith Weston is not especially affected by flooding with the exception of Normanton Road (opposite the car park) and some individual houses in the village. It was noted that some of the drains were blocked with leaves and that RCC had a programme of clearing drains.
